

Instruction

Magnet Schools

The Board recognizes that students may benefit from attending a state-approved public magnet school. This policy refers to magnet schools which offer open enrollment available to students from Andover, and require that the sending school district pay tuition.

The Superintendent shall include a line item in the annual budget for magnet school tuition. Such tuition will be subject to state regulations.

Nondiscrimination

The Board, the Superintendent, other administrators, and teachers shall not make any distinction on account of race, sex, sexual preference, ethnic group, religion, or disability of any student who may seek admission to any magnet school.

Transportation

Transportation outside the district will not be the responsibility of the Board of Education.
