

Bylaws of the Board

Number of Members, Terms of Office, Oath of Office

The Andover Board of Education consists of 7 members, serving 4 year overlapping terms. No more than 4 members can be from the same political party.

Any vacancy on the Board of Education, from whatever cause arising, shall be filled by appointment by the Board of Education until the next biennial election, except that if the Board of Education neglects to appoint such member within 30 days the Board of Selectmen may appoint a member to serve until the next annual election.

The Board of Education shall notify the Town Clerk of any Board of Education resignations.

Upon receiving notice of vacancy the Chairperson of the Board of Education shall notify the Chairperson of all major town political parties of the vacancy and request recommendations.

Term of office of Board of Education members shall be 4 years, each term beginning with the first day of July immediately following the election.

Members of Boards of Education shall, before entering upon their official duties, take the oath of office.
