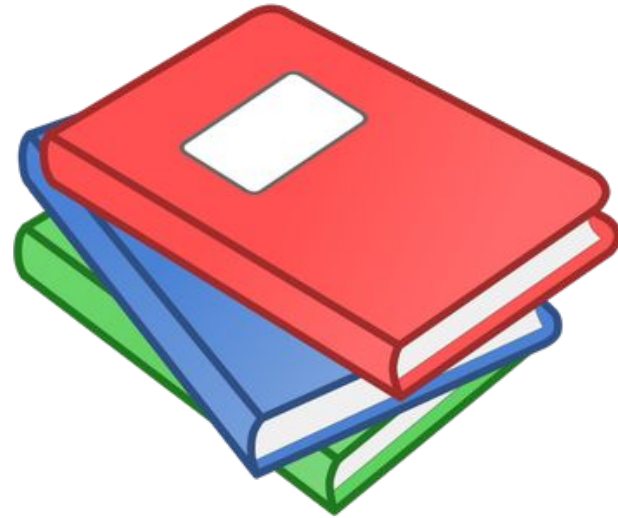

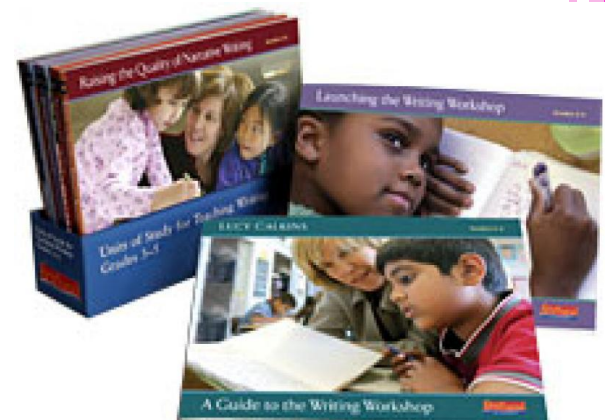

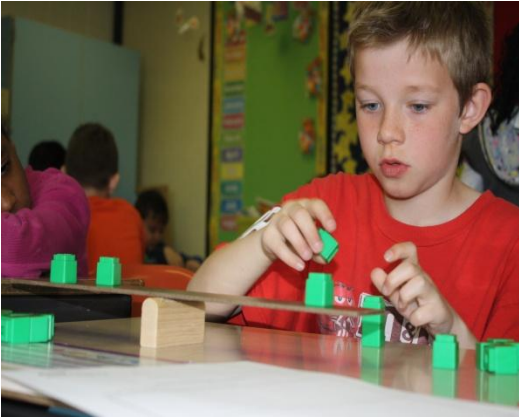


SPELLING

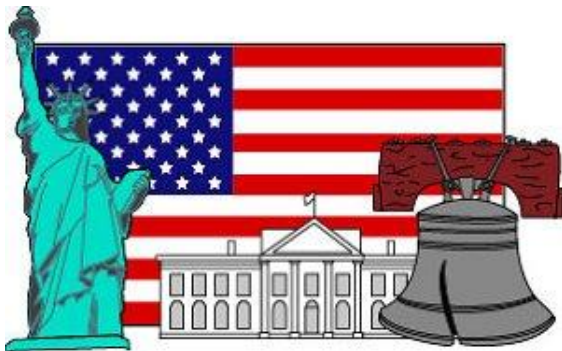
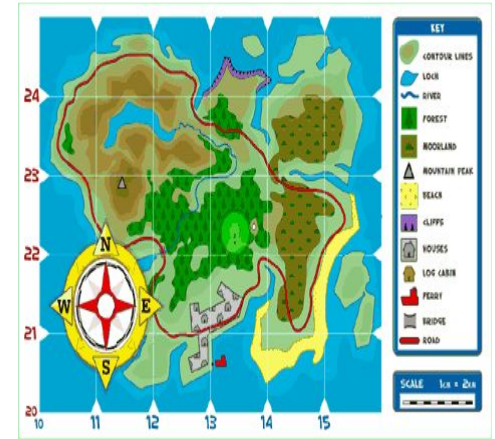
